

AGENCY: New Mexico Native American Business Development Center (NMNABDC)

DESCRIPTION: The NMNABDC provides management and technical assistance to qualified American Indian and minority individuals.

ELIGIBLE USES:

- The center can help with the market analysis, demographic profile, project feasibility, cash flow projection, and loan packaging aspects of your business plan.
- The center also offers financial services including project budgeting, structure financing, and financial statement preparation/summary.
- Business management services include management consulting, internal management solutions, and cost analysis.
- Capital development
- Marketing
- Procurement/contracting
- Accounting systems and organizational development
- Computer-assisted programs

PROGRAM/LOAN STRUCTURE:

- **Maximum Program Benefits:** The NMNABDC provides assistance in conjunction with the Minority Business Development Agency (MBDA). The MBDA is a federal agency created specifically to assist in the development of minority-owned businesses.
- **Fees:** Most general counseling and referral services are provided free of charge. Minimal fees are charged for some services.

QUALIFICATION CRITERIA/COMMENTS:

- Priority assistance will be targeted to the following groups:
 - Businesses with high employment potential,
 - Businesses with expansion or growth potential,
 - Businesses owned by minority women, or
 - Tribal enterprises.
- The proposed or existing business must be within the geographic boundaries of the NMNABDC service area (State of New Mexico).
