

**PROGRAM:** New Mexico Procurement Assistance Program

**AGENCY:** New Mexico General Services Department

**DESCRIPTION:** GSD provides contracting centers where businesses can seek advice and assistance in public procurement; it is also where federal, state, and local government agencies can seek suppliers to meet their needs.

**ELIGIBLE USES:**

- Access is provided to:
  - Computerized matching and bid opportunities,
  - Group workshops and training sessions, and
  - Individual consultation on preparing for contract opportunities with government agencies and large corporations.
- All businesses are eligible. Priority is given to economically distressed counties, minority and women-owned businesses.

**PROGRAM/LOAN STRUCTURE:**

- Fees: Minimal fees are charged for registration and marketing catalogs.

**QUALIFICATION CRITERIA/COMMENTS:**

- There are five contracting centers located in:
  - Alamogordo serving Dona Ana, Grant, Hidalgo, Luna, Otero and Sierra counties;
  - Albuquerque serving Bernalillo, Sandoval, Socorro, Torrance and Valencia counties;
  - Farmington serving Catron, Cibola, McKinley and San Juan counties;
  - Clovis serving Chaves, Curry, De Baca, Eddy, Lea, Lincoln and Roosevelt counties; and
  - Santa Fe serving Colfax, Guadalupe, Harding, Los Alamos, Mora, Quay, Rio Arriba, Santa Fe, San Miguel, Taos and Union counties.
