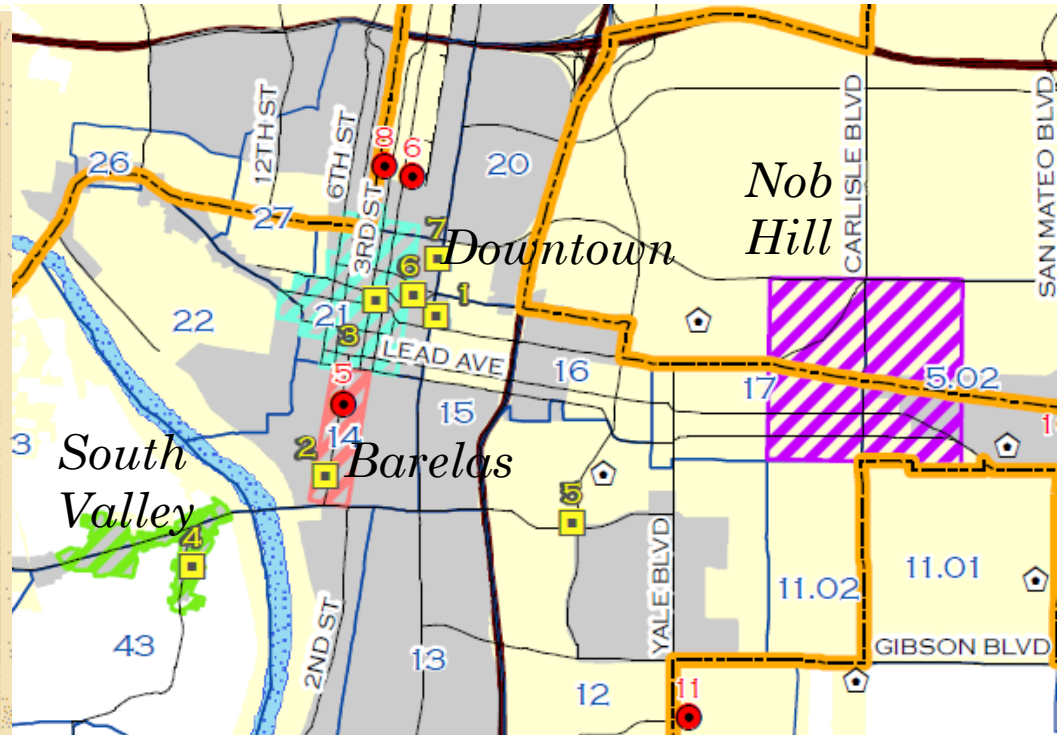

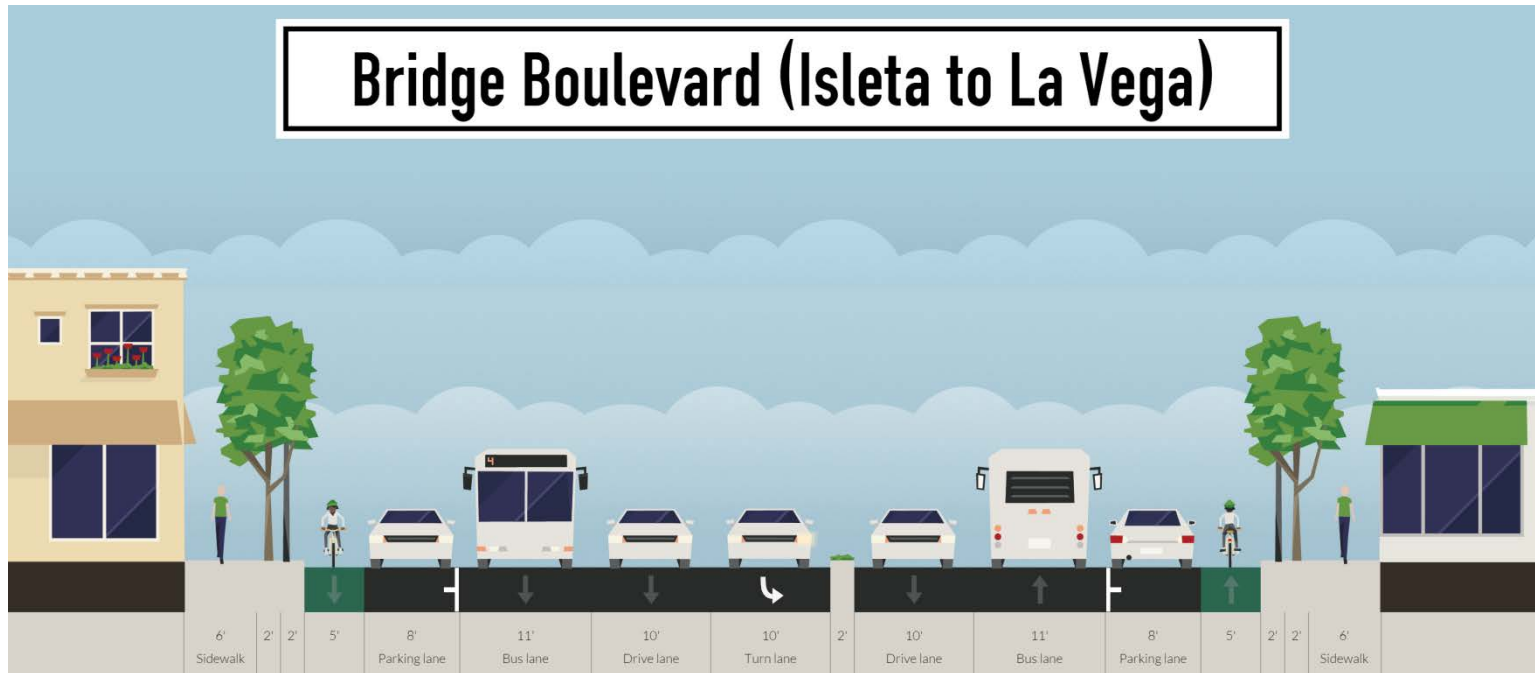
What is the character of the South Valley?

Complete Street Standards:

Alternatives to AASHTO Green Book (approved by FHWA):

- ITE CSS
- NACTO

Narrow travel lanes - 10 ft (cars) to 11 ft (buses, trucks) to:

- Reduce speeds (< 35 mph)
- Allow multi-modal facilities (cars, buses, pedestrians, bicycles)

- Gateway Monument

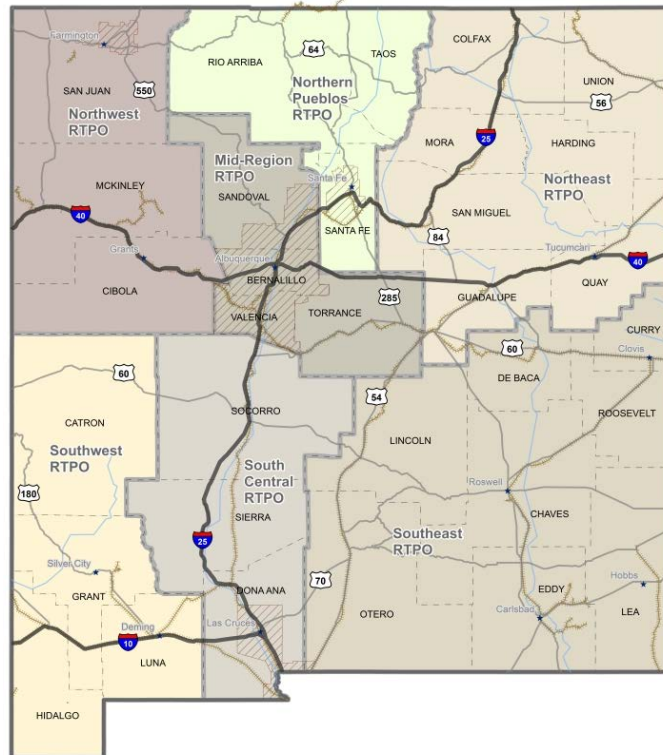
